How to register

1. You can register online, by mail, by postmail. An email confirming your registration will be sent you.
2. Visit the Congress Registration Desk in the Congress Hub when you arrive onsite to pick up your receipt, official access badge and registration package.
3. For the scholars who propose a paper, registration must be done for march, 31st, 2016.

To send a paper

Send to the ISP chairman an abstract (20 lines) of your paper (isp@insop.org). The abstracts must be emailed before December, 15th, 2016.

You will receive an email confirming that your paper is accepted or rejected.

Fees

The registration fees are broken down into two components – the **Congress fee** and the **accommodations fee**.

Registration fee for participants includes

- Admission to scientific sessions
- Congress bag with numerous congress documents
- Opening / Award Ceremony and Welcome Reception
- European CME credits
- Certificate of attendance

The Congress fee is **mandatory** for all attendees including speakers, presenters, panelists and those chairing or attending a session. Congress fee prior to March 31st:

- Regular: \$450
- Students, retired and unwaged: \$280
- The accommodation fee for the speakers of the congress (hotel, diner) will be proposed to each speaker by level of quality of accommodation.

Terms and conditions:

- All mail forms must be received by **December, 15th, 2015**. After that date, only online or onsite registrations are accepted.
- A \$25 administration fee will be added in cases of insufficient funds or invalid credit card numbers.
- Telephone registrations cannot be accepted.
- All registration forms must be completely filled out and be accompanied by full payment of fees.
- Cancellations are accepted until April 15, 2016, subject to a \$20 service fee. Unfortunately, no refunds are possible after this date.
